DISTRIBUTIVE POLICY

POLICY

A **distributive policy** is a statement on the distribution of goods, services and benefits to the membership, including members of the governing structure. Additionally it includes distributing the cost amongst the members of the Association.

(A) The endorsement of a distributive policy shall require the signature of at least two signing officers of the Association.

PROCEDURE

- 1. The following stages of a policy cycle shall serve as a guiding principle for policy development:
 - 1. Identification;
 - 1. Any member of the Board or Executive may bring forth a specific subject matter that may require action.
 - 2. Consultation;
 - 1. Any member of the Board may proceed with consultation within the Association governing structure, however consultation with stakeholders shall be conducted only under the approval of the President or by a Board majority vote.
 - 3. Policy Formulation;
 - 1. Any member of the Board or President may develop or appoint any person to develop a policy.
 - 2. The Board or President reserves the right to include any additional resources in the policy formulation process.
 - 4. Decision:
 - 1. A final decision to endorse the policy shall be determined by the Board of Directors.
