Re: Paramedic Core-Flex Staffing Model

Dear Minister Gray:

As a representative organization for its members, the Alberta Paramedic Association's (the Association) mission is to enhance knowledge, skills and the health and wellness of Alberta's Paramedics (Paramedics).

Members of our Association have expressed great concern with the current EMS staffing model, commonly referred as Core-Flex, as it poses psychological and physiological health risk to Paramedics, and, by extension, significant risk to the public. Core-Flex is a staffing model which requires Paramedics to be on a scheduled shift for an excessive period of time, such as forty-eight (48) hours, ninety-six (96) hours or even seven (7) days straight.

Relative to these concerns, I would like to discuss the new employment standards and how they relate to the Core-Flex model to identify opportunities that could reduce the negative impact on both paramedics and the public. I can be reached at dusty@albertaparamedics.ca or 780-904-3619.
